WMF meets Salzburg

1. AI will become one of the most important tools in mycotoxin research & management incl. improved & automated **risk assessment & detoxification**
2. **Smart analytical approaches = cost-effective & sustainable screening combined with automation in confirmatory lab analysis**
3. Geopolitics/conflicts are likely to play a growing role in human and livestock exposure to mycotoxins
4. **Emerging evidence links mycotoxins to chronic diseases, incl. neurodegeneration & cancer => investigate long-term, low-dose exposures**
5. Addressing mycotoxin challenges requires a holistic, **One Health** approach with insights from multiple disciplines to consider the **interconnectedness** of **human, animal & environmental health** for effective mitigation & surveillance

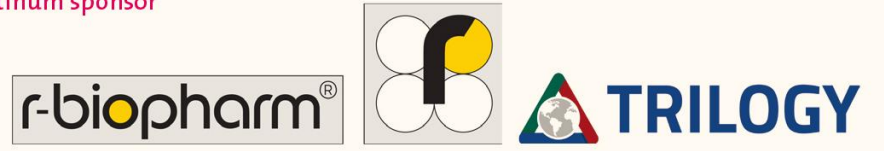
